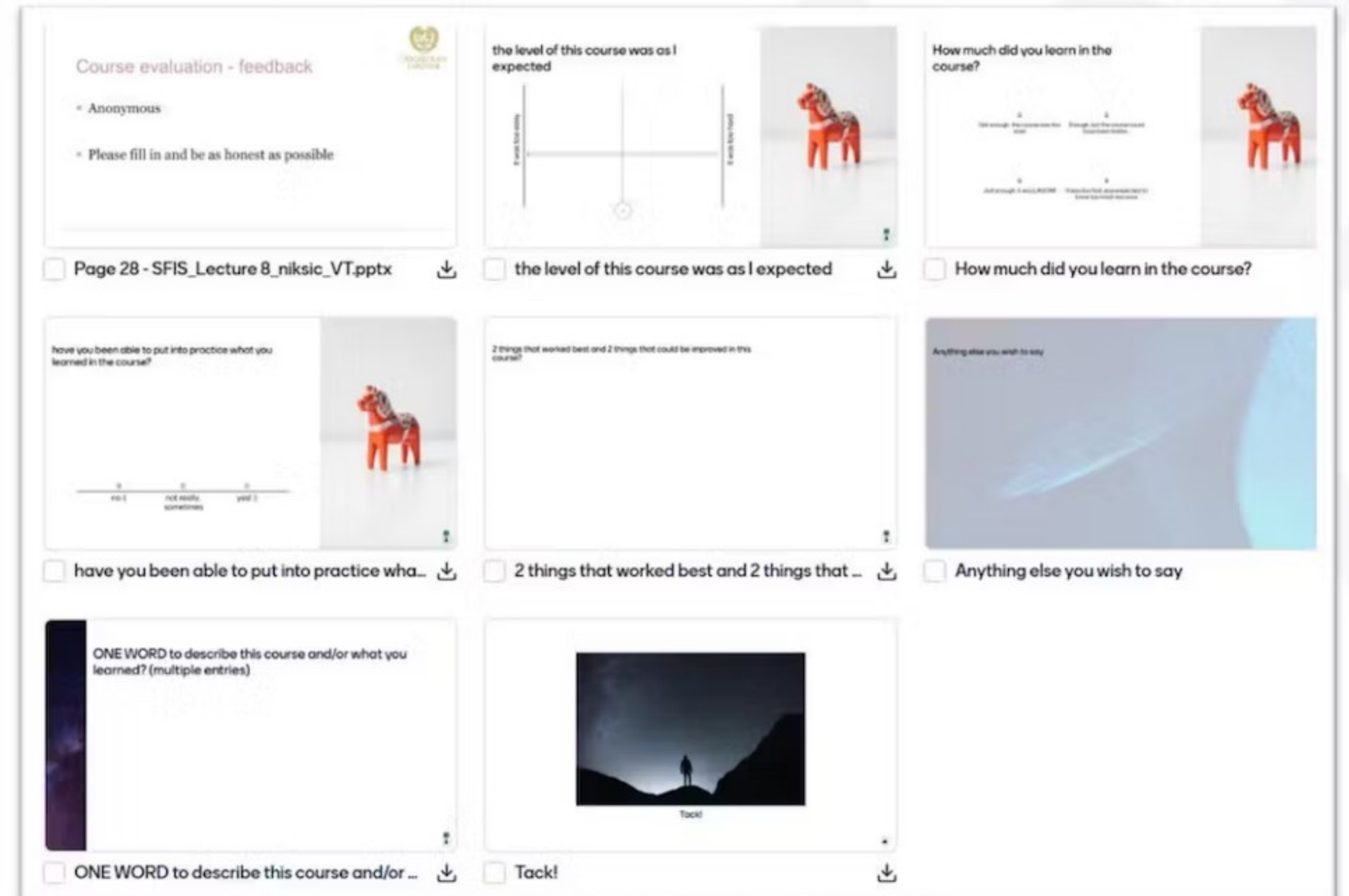
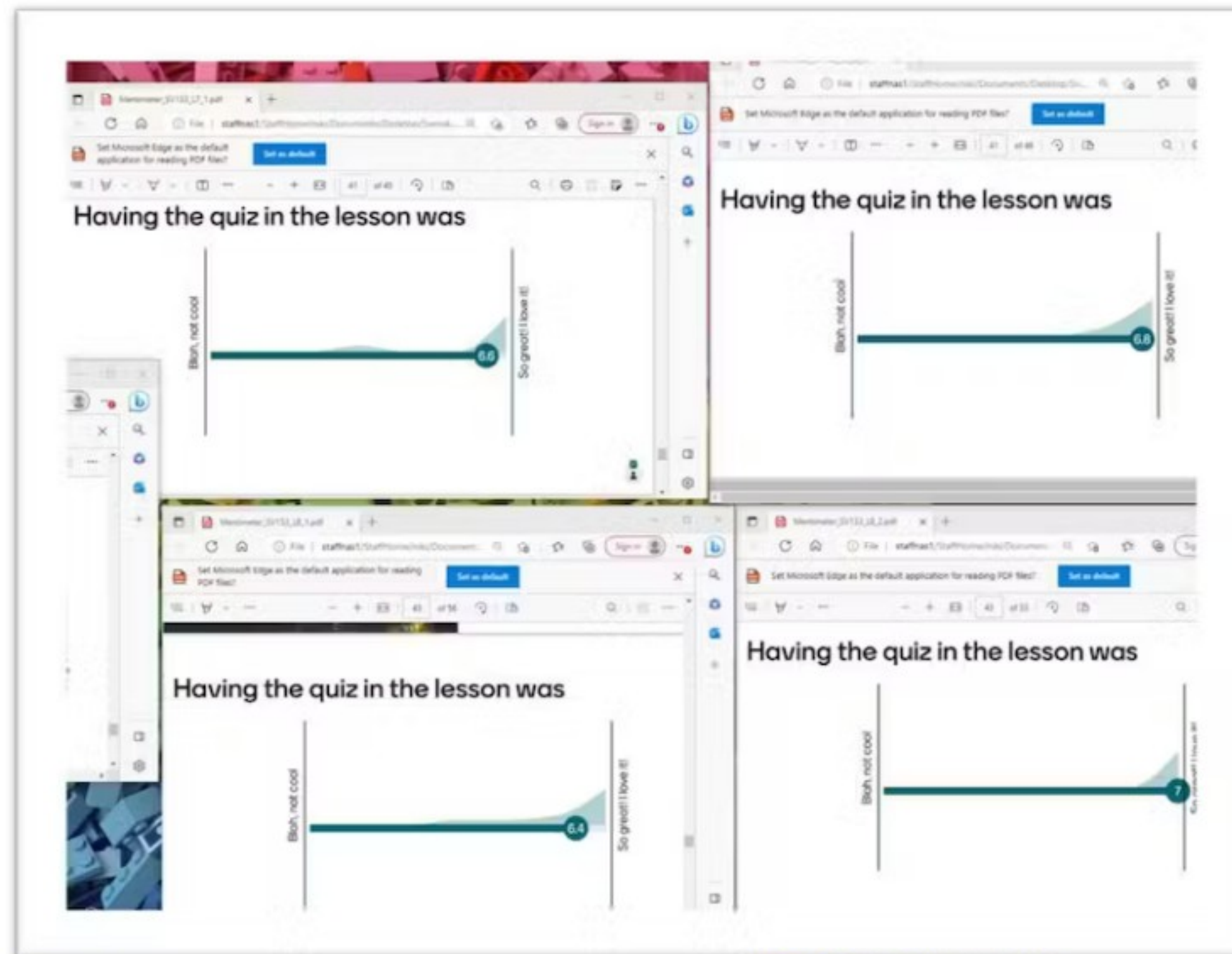
Generates feedback information that can be used:

- By teachers – to re-align their **teaching**

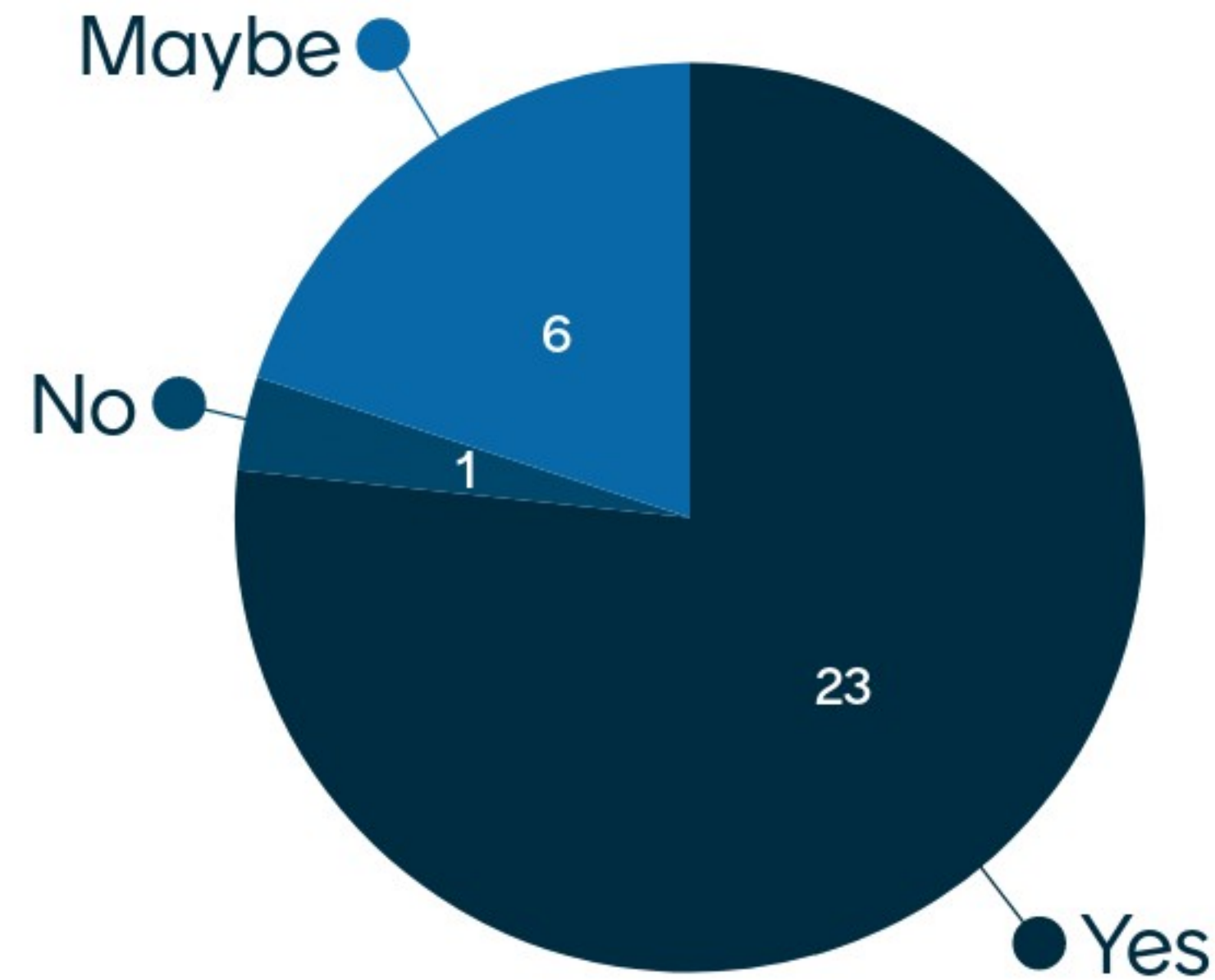
