



Traveling to lași

Getting to lași is easy, with several travel options depending on your arrival point.



by Plane

The fastest way is to fly directly to lași International Airport (IAS), located just 8 km from the city centre. If you land first in Bucharest Henri Coandă International Airport (OTP), you can:

- take a domestic flight to lași (1 hour), or
- continue by train or bus (6–7 hours).

by Train

From Bucharest Airport (OTP), take the train shuttle to Gara de Nord railway station (~20 minutes, 1–2 EUR). From there, trains to lași run frequently (6–6.5 hours). Tickets can be purchased at the station or online.

by Bus/Car

Buses connect lași with Bucharest and other Romanian cities. Traveling by car or carpooling is also a sustainable and budget-friendly choice, especially if you come from neighbouring countries.

How to get around in Iasi

Public Transport

Bus & Tram (CTP Iași): tickets cost ~0.8 EUR (one trip) or 1.6 EUR (two trips), valid for 120 minutes. Payment options:

- by card directly in the vehicle,
- via the 24Pay mobile app (single, daily, or multi-trip tickets).

Uber/Taxi/Bolt



Taxis and transport services like Uber and Bolt are safe, widely available and rather affordable.


By Taxi – approximately 0.6 – 0.8 EUR start fee, 0.6 EUR/km. You will need some local currency in cash as some drivers do not have POS.

Expect to pay around 10–15 EUR from the airport to the city centre (a longer fare compared to usual).


By Uber/Bolt – fees vary depending on traffic and weather conditions.

The Palace of Culture


A Neo-Gothic landmark and the symbol of Iași. Built on medieval foundations, it now houses four major museums.


Copou Park & Eminescu's Linden Tree

Local currency



Romanian Leu (RON). **1 EUR ≈ 5 RON** (rate may vary). You will need local currency for artisans and other local products sold at street boutiques. In shops, malls, and supermarkets you can pay by card.

Time zone

In Romania, the standard time is Eastern European Time / GMT + 3 / Central European Time + 1

Power plugs

For Romania there are two associated plug types, types C and F. Plug type C is the plug which has two round pins and plug type F is the plug which has two round pins with two earth clips on the side. Romania operates on a 230V supply voltage and 50Hz.

The **TUIASI campus** is located close to the city center.



From central hotels: ~20 min walk or short bus/tram ride (0.8 EUR per trip).


FIKA - Scandinavian-inspired coffee shop with specialty coffee.
